Dear Kristin:

As you know, this firm represents RIP Holdings, LLC (“Developer”) in connection with the expansion of Profound Technologies’ building and related improvements at 125 Little Conestoga Road (“Development”). Developer and the Township entered into Land Development and Financial Security Agreements for site improvements in the Development dated May 13, 2020 (collectively, the “Agreements”). Under the Agreements Developer is required to complete the site improvements within one year from the date of Agreement. Accordingly, the one year period will expire on May 13, 2021.

While Developer is close to completion of site improvements and anticipates being in a position to request final inspection relatively soon, this will not have occurred by May 13, 2021. Accordingly, in order to allow time for completion and close out of the site improvement obligations, Developer is requesting an extension of the time period to complete improvements in the Development until September 30, 2021.

Dear Kristin:

As you know, this firm represents Marsh Lea 27 LLC c/o Moser Construction Management, LLC ("Moser") in connection with the Marsh Lea residential development in the Township ("Development"). The Development consists of single-family detached lots and improvements in both Upper Uwchlan Township and Wallace Township. Moser entered into a Land Development Agreement and a Financial Security Agreement with Upper Uwchlan Township dated December 18, 2017 for site improvements. These Agreements contemplate that certain of the site improvements, including the road are to be offered for dedication to Upper Uwchlan Township.

Previously, the Board of Supervisors granted an extension to Moser for completion of site improvements through May 31, 2021. Due to weather delays, the road was not top coated in the fall; however, Moser is diligently working to complete improvements and anticipates commencing the dedication process in the next 30 days. Accordingly, Moser is requesting an additional extension of time to complete this process through September 30, 2021.

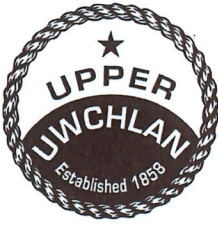

Attached to this memo is a draft resolution supporting an application to import a restaurant liquor license into Upper Uwchlan Township from Malvern Borough/Willistown Township to be utilized at the Epicurean Garage. The Epicurean Garage's parent organization, Garage Ventures, Inc, will be the licensee. The license is coming from a closed restaurant in Malvern.

The Board of Supervisors previously supported Epicurean Garage's application for an economic development license, but that application was not successful. The resolution will be before the Board on May 17th for consideration.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF UPPER UWCHLAN TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF CHESTER, PENNSYLVANIA, IN SUPPORT OF THE TRANSFER OF RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE NO. R-18869 INTO UPPER UWCHLAN TOWNSHIP FROM MALVERN

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Liquor Code, 47 P.S. § 1-101 et seq. (“Liquor Code”) authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of restaurant liquor licenses as provided for in Section 461 of the Liquor Code if, as in Upper Uwchlan Township, sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Code requires the applicant to obtain from the receiving municipality a resolution approving the applicant’s request for an intermunicipal transfer of a liquor license prior to an applicant’s submission of an application to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control board; and

WHEREAS, an application for transfer filed under the Liquor Code must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of a restaurant liquor license into the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Garage Ventures, Inc. has requested the approval of the Upper Uwchlan Township Board of Supervisors for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania restaurant liquor license No. R-18869 by Garage Ventures, Inc. to restaurant facilities within the Township of Upper Uwchlan to be located at 570 Simpson Drive, Upper Uwchlan, Chester County Pennsylvania with the understanding that said transfer must be approved at a later date by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Uwchlan approves by adoption of this Resolution, the proposed transfer of restaurant liquor license No. R-18869 into the Township of Upper Uwchlan by Garage Ventures, Inc. and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that transfer, designations and assignments of licenses hereunder are subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
