Upper Uwchlan Township Awarded ARLE Grant Funding

CHESTER SPRINGS, PA . Governor Corbett has announced the award of \$8.4 million dollars of Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) grants to 106 transportation projects across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania funded through fines collected from red light enforcement cameras in Philadelphia. Upper Uwchlan Township has been awarded \$614,625 for safety and mobility improvements on the Route 100 corridor, one of the major north/south thoroughfares thru Chester County. The funds will be used to design, permit, and install an Adaptive Traffic Signal Control System with the goal of maximizing capacity without road widening and allowing for immediate responsiveness in times of emergent need such as a closure of the Pennsylvania Turnpike or other major local thoroughfares which would result in significant increases of volume on local roadways in Upper Uwchlan Township. Eleven traffic signals are included in the project including all traffic signals on Route 100 in Upper Uwchlan Township, the traffic signals located on Graphite Mine Road, Little Conestoga Road/Park Road, and the signal located at Route 100/Eagleview Boulevard in Uwchlan Township. Upper Uwchlan Township would like to thank Governor Corbett, PennDOT, the Chester County Planning Commission, and all others involved in this process for their support.
