

Make the call or click before you dig

It takes approximately four and a half minutes to create a ticket when calling **811**—compared to four and a half days (or more) of lost time if an underground utility is struck because you didn't call **811**.

Calling **811** or using **clickbeforeyoudig.com** doesn't just protect the integrity of our pipelines, it can protect your business and save your life.

One of the leading causes of pipeline failure is damage resulting from nearby excavation. In 2022, 233,810 incidents involving damage occurred on underground infrastructure across the U.S.¹

By making a call to **811** or visiting **clickbeforeyoudig.com** at least two to three days prior to any soil-disturbing project (depending on state law), you become part of the solution to protecting underground infrastructure, including the pipelines that bring a vital source of energy to you and your neighbors on a daily basis. Making the call to **811** or using **clickbeforeyoudig.com** is **free**, and doing so contributes to the safety of you, your crew and anyone else who may be near. It may save your life.

The depth of pipelines and other utilities can change over time due to erosion, shifting soils or other factors.

Calling 811 or using clickbeforeyoudig.com prior to any earth-moving activity is not only the law in all 50 states, doing so can help to prevent unnecessary costs or job delays and can even save a life.

I have some drainage canals on my property. Do I need to call 811 when I'm doing maintenance on them?

While it may seem like a routine task, maintenance on drainage ditches and canals can be hazardous. Pipelines and other utilities can cross these canals, often concealed by water and/or soil.
